Essential Items to Include in Your Pet Emergency Kit

By being prepared, you can make sure that your pets are taken care of in any emergency situation.

Use this list as a guide:

- Three-Day Supply of Fresh Food & Water
- Necessary Pet Medications, Food and Water Dishes, Hand Can Opener, Pet Waste Disposable Bags, Bagged Cat Litter & Pan/Scoop for Cats
- Collars, Harnesses, Leashes, Tags, Pet Carrier for Each Pet, Familiar Bedding, Toys, and Treats
- Pet ID in a Plastic Baggie, Photos, Microchip Information, License Number, Vaccination Records, Prescription Information, Other Medical Information
