## **DACC CONTINUES TO PROVIDE ANIMAL SERVICES**

LONG BEACH, Calif. — The County of Los Angeles Department of Animal Care and Control (DACC) continues to staff emergency shelters for animals and respond to requests for assistance due to the rainstorm event. Heavy rainfall is expected to begin tonight through Friday morning. The only current area of mandatory evacuation is the La Tuna Canyon area.

DACC encourages residents in the affected areas to take necessary steps to protect themselves and their animals.
